

# FRAZER NASH FREDDIE GILES



## Memorial Trophy

**T**he Frazer Nash Car Club is delighted to be the star marque of the 2025 Autumn Classic, commemorating its shared history with the circuit since 1963, when AFN Castle Combe was formed - AFN being marque founder Archie Frazer Nash's initials.

Frazer Nashes on display in the marquee include the famous AFP Fane twin-blown Gough-engined single-seater; the FN Archive's ex-Stirling Moss Le Mans Rep WMC 181 and both cars featured on this year's poster, Le Mans Rep VMF 701 and High-Speed TME 924, first and second here in October 1950 driven by Moss and Tony Crook.

The Freddie Giles Memorial trophy race is running for the 7th year, in memory of the charismatic ex-FN Captain and

hero from Bromham, near Devizes, close to Castle Combe. His favourite car, TT Rep MV 1764, will be racing today, driven by son Jon.

Today's grid includes a handful of post-war examples. It is largely made up of road going sports cars, ranging from regularly raced 'hot-engined' Nashes, to standard Anzani-engined cars, as fitted by the factory, so expect a huge speed differential. The vast majority are Meadows-engined, but AC, BMW and Bugatti power units are also represented. Bugatti specialist Charles Knill-Jones' car makes its race debut today, driven by 2020 and 2021 Combe victor Tom Waterfield.
