Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK

Ch.12 App.7 Art.1.8 - Causing a collision, repetition of serious mistakes or the appearance of a lack of control over the car (such as leaving the track)

### **Brief Details:**

Car 148 reported to make contact with car 30 causing car 30 to spin and continue.

Drivers of both cars were interviewed where driver of car 148 explained he'd outbraked himself causing contact between his front left and the rear right of car 30. This caused car 30 to spin.

Car 148 tried to slow to allow car 30 to re-pass but unknown to them car 30 had made light contact with the tyre bund on the apex of the chicane.

The cars finished one behind the other, and so a 2 second penalty will be applied to car 148 to switch them back around.

### **Evidence Relied Upon:**

In car video footage from car 148 and interviews with both drivers.
