

CASTLE COMBE CIRCUIT TRACK DAYS

KEEPING YOU SAFE ON AND OFF TRACK

- You must complete the indemnity form before your day. If you are unable to do this, then please ensure that you bring a printout on the day.
- Entry to the Circuit will be from 07:00. If you arrive earlier and the gate is locked, please do not park in the gateway or indeed queue out onto the road. Please drive away from the circuit and return when the gate is open.
- Noise testing will take place from 08:00 with the safety briefing held at 08:45, we will run later ones, but please try to come to the first one, to ensure a prompt start.
- Please respect our neighbours & local community when driving to & from the Circuit
- Food & Drink is available to purchase throughout the day from the Café

YOU MUST HAVE YOUR DRIVING LICENCE WITH YOU ON THE DAY, FAILURE TO PRODUCE IT WILL RESULT IN NOT BEING ALLOWED TO TAKE PART ON TRACK

Frequently Asked Questions:

Can my trailered vehicle be dropped off by another person?

Yes, please advise us of this in advance

Camp the night before the track day?

Contact us and be aware that you must be on site by 6pm as gates are locked. Do not park up for the night outside the main entrance, you are welcome to park outside any of the other circuit gates.

Can I leave my car on site overnight?

Speak to the Track Manager at the NANKANG Bridge, alternatively come to the Circuit office to arrange. Please be aware there is no security on site and you are leaving your property on site at your own risk.

Is Merlin Motorsport open?

Merlin is open 09:00-17:00 Monday-Friday.

New to Track instructions

On arrival & registering, you will be directed to the Noise Check area which is adjacent to NANKANG footbridge. The noise limit for the day is 100db(A) measured at ½ metre from the exhaust outlet, at 4500 revs.

Please then follow directions to your safety briefing where all the safety aspects of the day will be explained, if you do not attend the briefing, you will be unable to take part on the day.

All drivers will participate in a series of sighting laps following a course car around the circuit. The instructor will demonstrate the correct lines, braking and turning points for each corner.
